


## *Mary's Gift to Us*

Cooper just turned 8 years old and is on a life-long journey of coping with a rare genetic disease called Mucopolysaccharidosis or MPS IV A. He was diagnosed at 15 months and began weekly day long infusions at Children's Hospital. So far, he has had over 300 infusions. Last summer he had cervical surgery.

This February he received a Golden Lab, Velocity, as an assistance dog from Canine Companions for Independence. (Roscoe is the brown family dog) Early this summer Cooper had surgery on all hip, knee and ankle joints and was in a body cast for 6 weeks. But, with lots of prayers and good doctors, Cooper continues to be an avid hockey and baseball fan, took a family swim vacation in Glenwood, is a great 3rd grade student, the light of our lives and an inspiration to many.
