Mary's Homes of Hope provides homes in a Christ-centered community for all life from conception to natural end. Join us in welcoming Eli, born on September 7, 2021. Eli's mom, Ciara, has been a part of our ministry for a number of years.

We were first called by God, approximately twenty years ago, to establish homes for pregnant women and ultimately their born children and provide not only a place to live, but also a home where the love of Jesus and His Mother was ever present. A home where they knew they were moms of valued dignity and precious in God's eyes. When the moms had acquired the tools and support and ready to be on their own, for the most part, their only option was government housing. The waiting lists were up to two years or longer. Many had to go into temporary housing and with government requirements they were thrown into a dependent and God absent lifestyle.

So, there was a piece missing, a home to call their own in a Christ-centered community. A community where their faith would continue to grow in many ways to love and know God more.

Realizing a need to provide permanent homes not only for the moms and babies, there is a need to include a growing number of single unattached women, regardless of age and families as well.

Jesus, through Mary with St. Joseph, opened the first Mary's Homes of Hope home through the generosity of a devout Catholic family, on June 1st 2018 for pregnant moms and moms with born children and single unattached women. In the spring of 2018 Archbishop Aquilla gave MHOH permission to build a chapel with the Presence of the Blessed Sacrament making MHOH truly a Christ-centered home.

Our prayers continue for a home to provide for families. We keep in mind that all this is done in God's will. We rely on Divine Providence and do no fundraising, no grant writing, and take NO government funding. We make our needs known through our newsletter, parishes, faith groups, and individuals and most of all through prayers. Please pray for us! You are all in our prayers!

Mary's Homes of Hope continues to foster an environment that flourishes in faith, fellowship, and friendship in Christ and makes stronger disciples to "go out" and build up the Church!

October 7th Our Lady of the Rosary

The 20 Exercises on Mary's Role With Jesus, Through Jesus, and In Jesus



Pray the rosary everyday and you will be meditating on the birth, life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

The mysteries of the rosary are the Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious. Each mystery contains five events to meditate on as you pray the prayers. The following lays down the format of which day to pray each mystery and the scripture reference for each decade. Ask Our Lady to guide you giving you the grace contained in each decade of the mystery. When meditating on each decade visualize yourself with Mary present in the event of Christ's life. See where she guides you.

Journaling about your thoughts and inspirations will lead you deeper into each mystery and draw you closer to Christ through His Blessed Mother.

THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES

Pray On Mondays and Saturdays

1st Joyful Mystery – The Annunciation – Luke 1: 26-38

2nd Joyful Mystery – The Visitation – Luke 1: 39-56

3rd Joyful Mystery – Birth of Jesus – Luke 2: 1-20

4th Joyful Mystery – Presentation In the Temple – Luke 2: 22-40

5th Joyful Mystery – Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple – Luke 2: 41-52

Pray on Thursdays

1st Luminous Mystery – Baptism of Our Lord Jesus in the Jordan – Mark 1: 9-10

2nd Luminous Mystery – Wedding Feast at Cana – John 2: 1-5

3rd Luminous Mystery – Proclamation of the Kingdom – Matthew 4:23-25

4th Luminous Mystery Transfiguration of Jesus – Matthew 17: 1-3

5th Luminou Mystery—Institution of the Eucharist – Luke 22; 14-16

- 3rd Glorious Mystery – Descent of the Holy Spirit- Acts 1: 13-14 & Acts 2: 1-13 and Acts 2 41
- 4th Glorious Mystery – Assumption of Our Lady – Luke 1:46-55
- 5th Glorious Mystery – Mary Crowned Queen of Heaven & Earth – Rev 12: 1 & Ps. 45: 10, 14-18
