LIVING LENT

Lent described in the Catholic dictionary reads that it is the forty-day liturgical season of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving in preparation for Easter. The common question we hear is, "What are you giving up for lent?" We make a list and, for the most part, when lent is over we go back to those things which we gave up. Let us look toward almsgiving that will bring together the fasting and prayer that will last.

In Christian tradition almsgiving is a corporal work of mercy that includes feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick, and visiting prisoners. (Matthew 25:34-40) I'd like to share the ways the residents at Mary's Homes of Hope practice corporal works of mercy.



She prays! She is His light that shines on them and gives them hope.
