## A Stranger and You Welcomed Me

Through the time of Lent we are reminded to live Matthew 25. One of the things Christ asks of us is to welcome, love, and extend mercy to the least of these.

“Then the righteous will answer him and say, ‘Lord, when did we see you a stranger and welcome You?’

He replies, “...whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for Me.”

In this past Roe v. Wade time we are seeing more of a need for pregnant moms, moms with born children, and single women to have a place to live that is safe, **welcoming**, and loving.

There are at least 411 maternity homes throughout the U.S. and most are full. There seems to be more women seeking a place to live and receive

help they need and fewer seeking an abortion. That is God’s grace at work.

Some years ago we were part of helping to establish Shepherd Homes for pregnant moms. Over a short period of time thirteen Shepherd Homes offered to open their doors to pregnant moms. A protocol of on-going support and guidance was put into place.

Many babies were born, some baptized, some moms converted to the Catholic Church, and all knew they were loved by their Christ-centered families. It seems to be time to re-establish Shepherd Homes.
