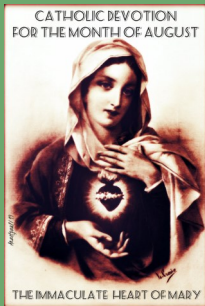

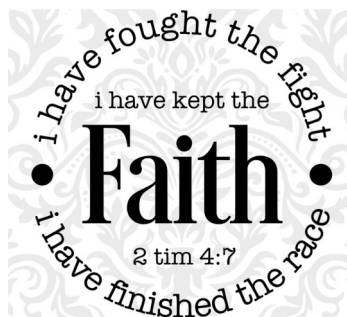
NEW PRIEST!
